

Did you Know

1. Cruise Rates advertised on line for Sales (even from the specific cruise lines) do not “usually” include taxes or port fees. Rates are per person and taxes and port fees are added on at check-out and can range from \$90.00 to greater than \$200.00 depending on the length of your cruise and specific ports visited.
 - a. If you email (or call) me for a quote, my rate will always include total price (total for your stateroom inclusive of tax and port fees).
 - b. Tips are added on by the cruise line and can be paid any time before you leave the ship at the end of your Cruise. You may pay your tips ahead of time (one less thing to worry about) by just letting me know up to two days before you board.
2. Group Rates Available – Family Reunion, Church Group, Girls Outing, or just get a group of your besties together and we can block out groups of cabins on many sailings. Sometimes this will allow discounted pricing that is lower than the standard rate. Normally free perks can be added in (i.e. on board credit, free photo, etc) that depend on how many people join your group.
